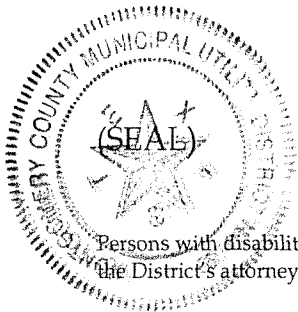


NOTICE OF MEETING

MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 89

The Board of Directors of Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 89 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, May 7, 2015, at 11:00 a.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2600, Colorado Conference Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Consider Agreement with the Legends Ranch Property Owners Association to fund streetlights.
3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments, and tax assessment and collections matters.
4. Travel Reimbursement Guidelines and Director Expenses for the Association of Water Board Directors summer conference.
5. Drainage channel maintenance, including proposal to clean and maintain additional tracts.
6. Engineering matters.
7. Amendment to wastewater facilities lease agreement.
8. Status of design for wastewater treatment plant.
9. Adopt Resolution Expressing Intent to Reimburse Operating Fund from Bond Proceeds.
10. Status of the TPDES permit application.
11. Long term plan.
12. Pay estimates, change orders, and/or final acceptance, as appropriate, for water plant no. 1 improvements, including hydropneumatic tank no. 3.
13. Storm Water Permitting Matters.
14. Deeds and Easements and authorize Phase I environmental surveys requested for acceptance of donated tracts.
15. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs and maintenance.
16. Conduct hearing regarding termination of utility service to customers with delinquent accounts and authorize termination of service.
17. Review Critical Load Spreadsheet for District's facilities and authorize filing of updated information, if appropriate.
18. Approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to mail Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of mailing with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
19. Report on implementation of groundwater reduction plan agreement.
